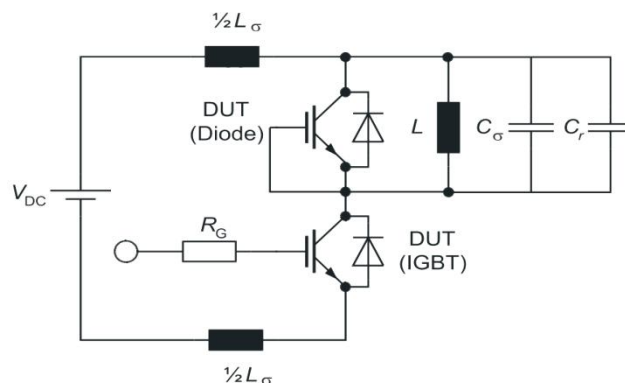

1) Gate Charge Test Circuit

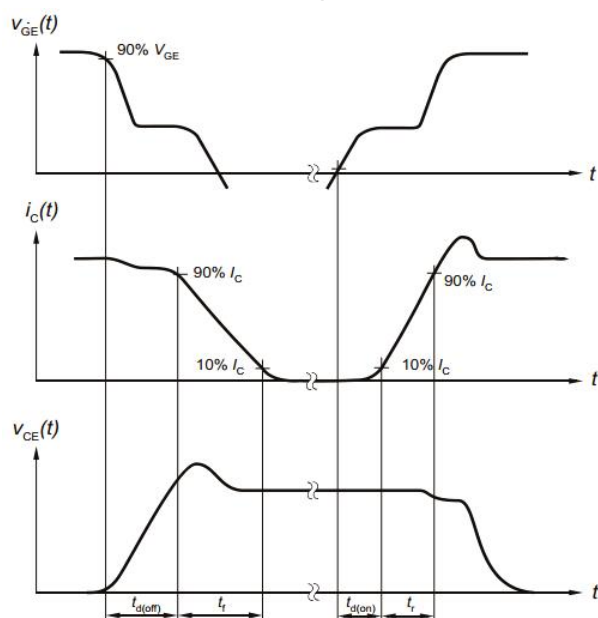


2) Switch Time Test Circuit

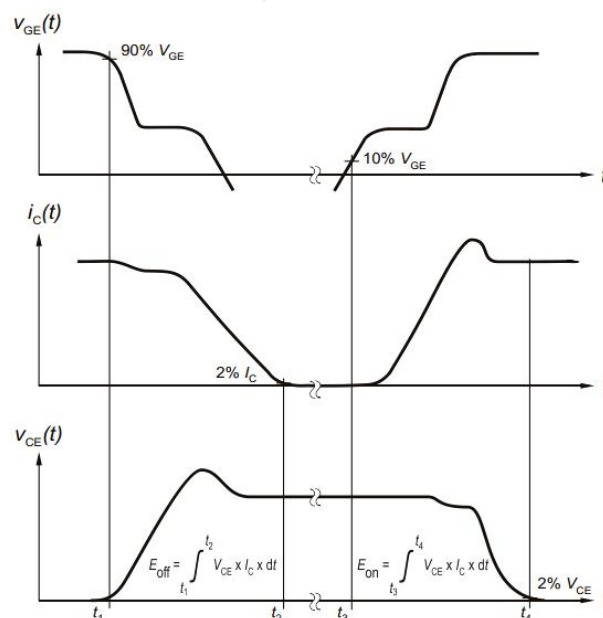

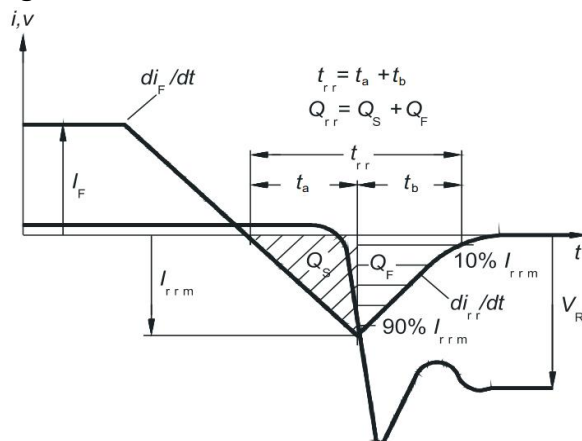
1) Definition of switching times

Figure 1 Output Characteristics

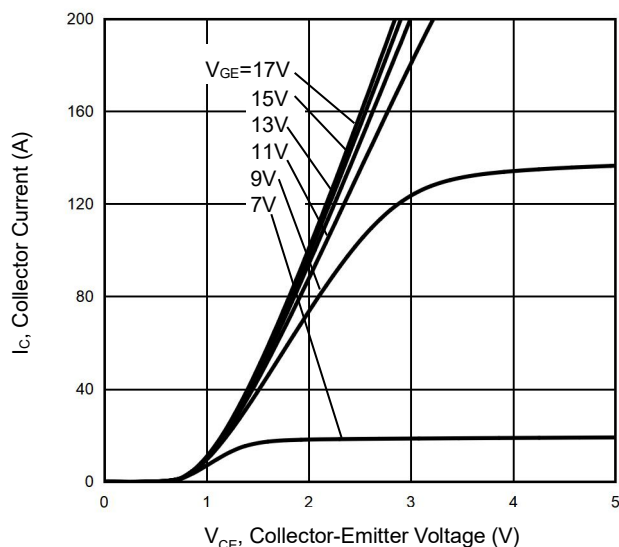


Figure 2 Transfer Characteristics

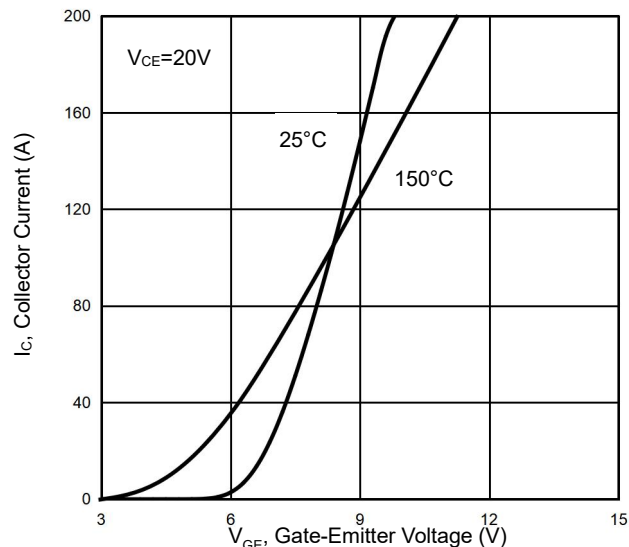


Figure 3 $V_{CE(sat)}$ vs. Case Temperature

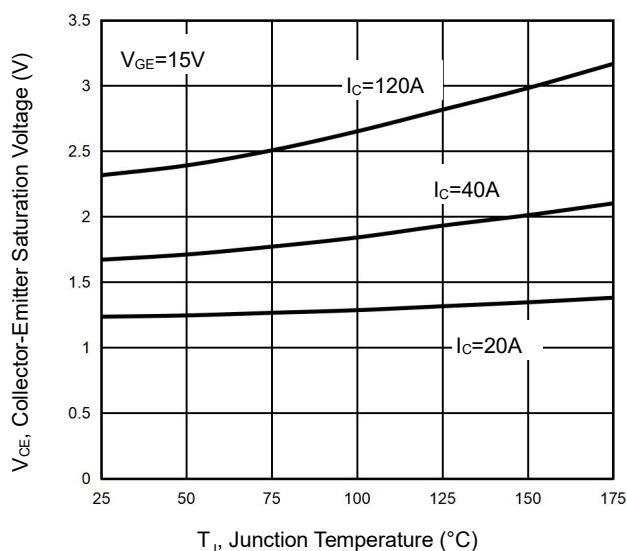


Figure 4 Saturation Voltage vs. V_{GE}

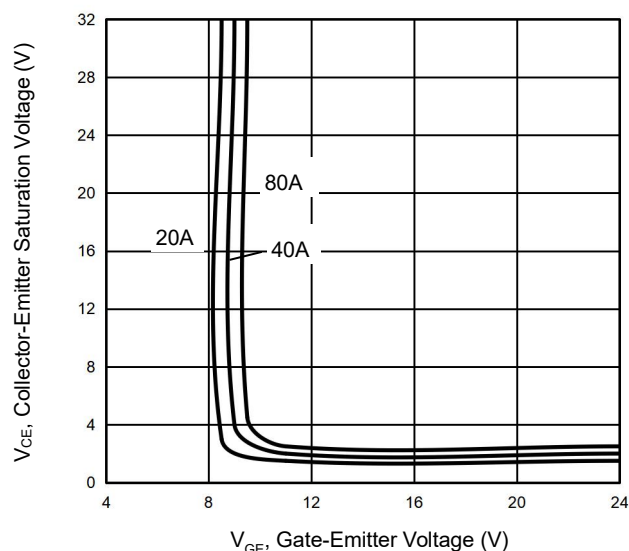


Figure 5 Capacitance Characteristics

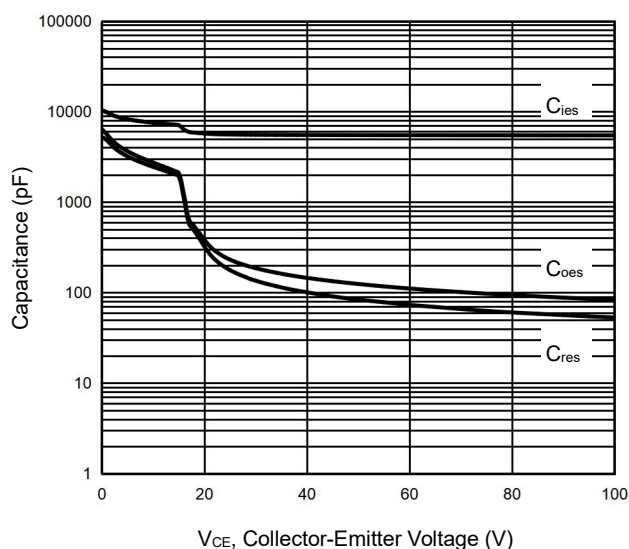
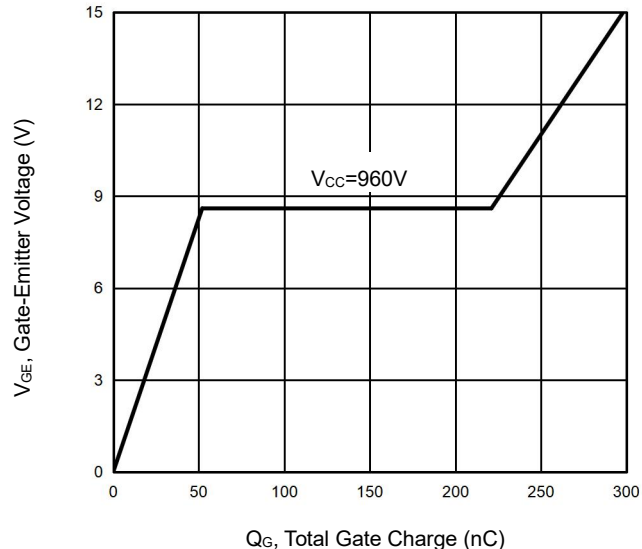


Figure 6 Gate Charge Wave Form

Figure 7 Forward Characteristics

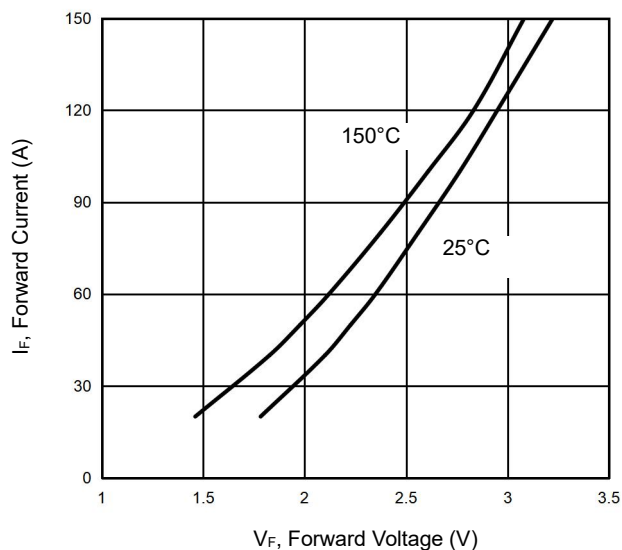


Figure 8 V_F vs. Temperature

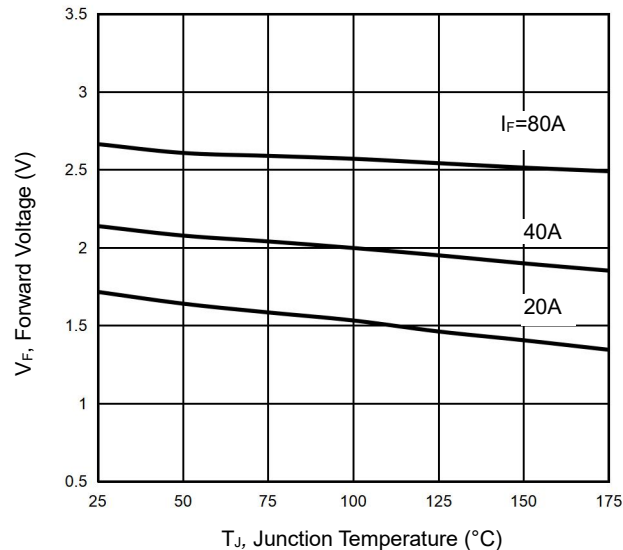


Figure 9 Switching Energy vs. Temperature

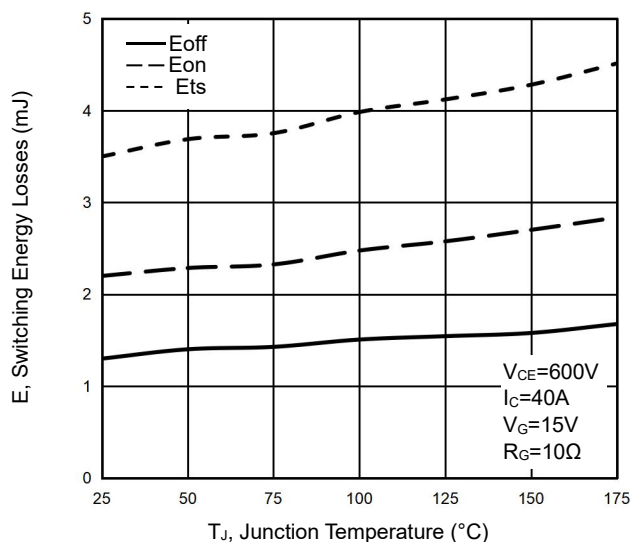


Figure 10 Forward Bias Safe Operating Area

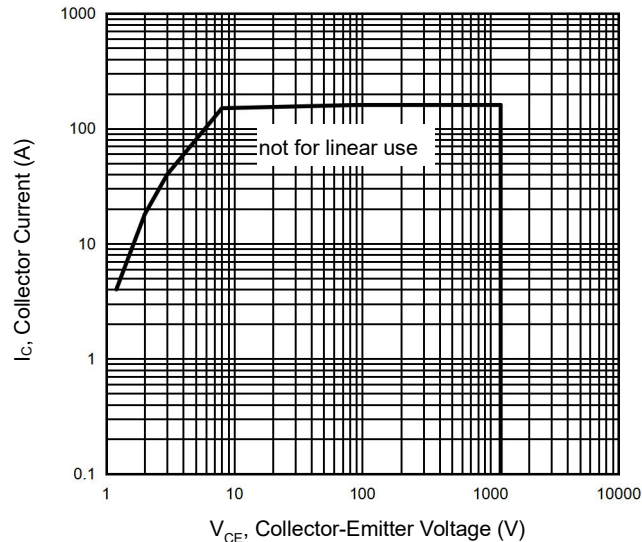


Figure 11 Gate-Emitter Threshold Voltage as a Function of Junction Temperature

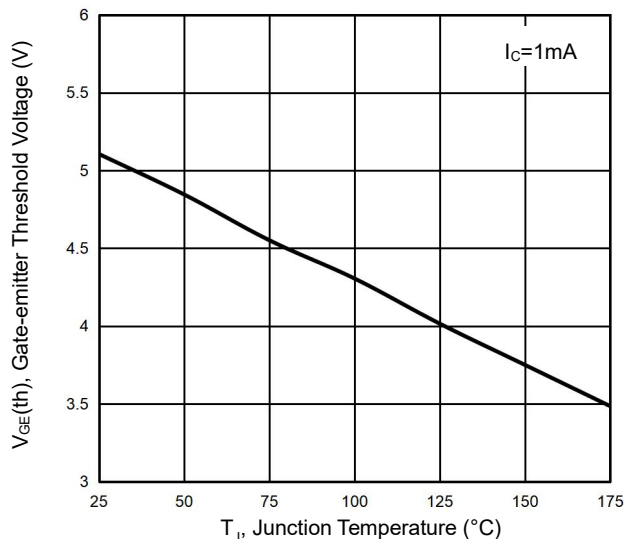
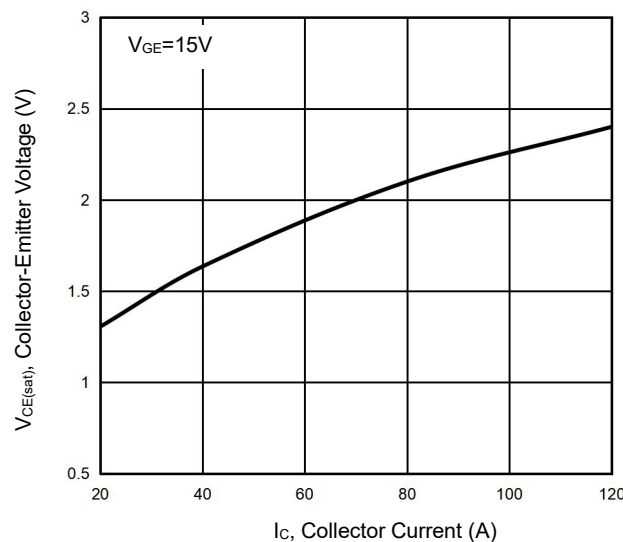


Figure 12 Typical Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage as a function of Collector Current

Figure 13 Switching Loss vs. R_G

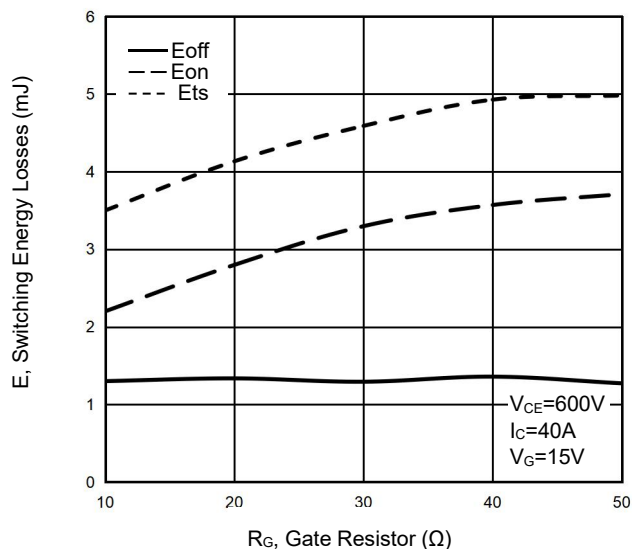


Figure 14 Switching Loss vs. Collector Current

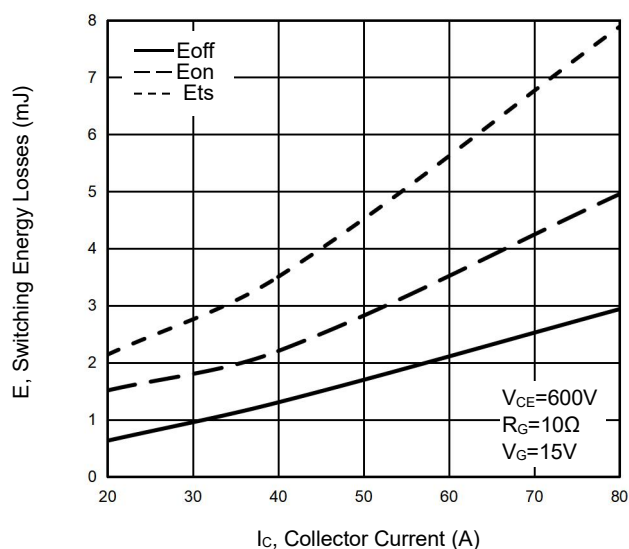


Figure 15 Switching Loss vs. Collector Current

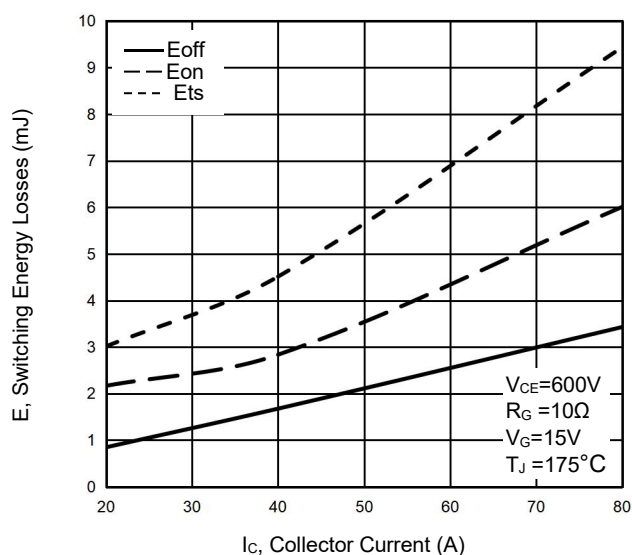


Figure 16 P_{tot} vs. Case Temperature

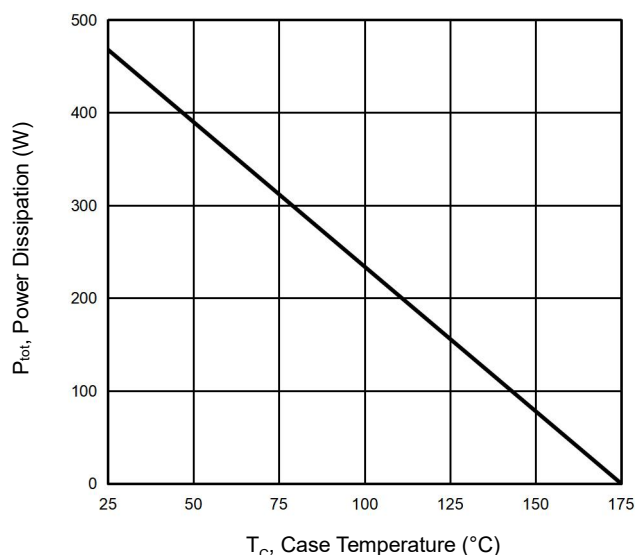


Figure 17 V_{CES} vs. Temperature

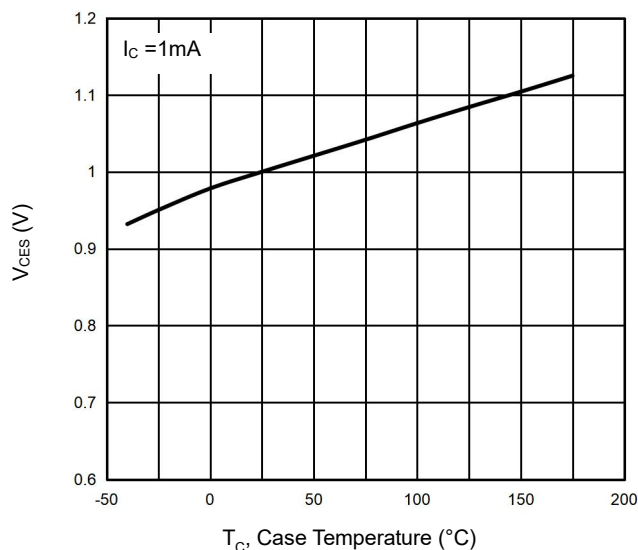
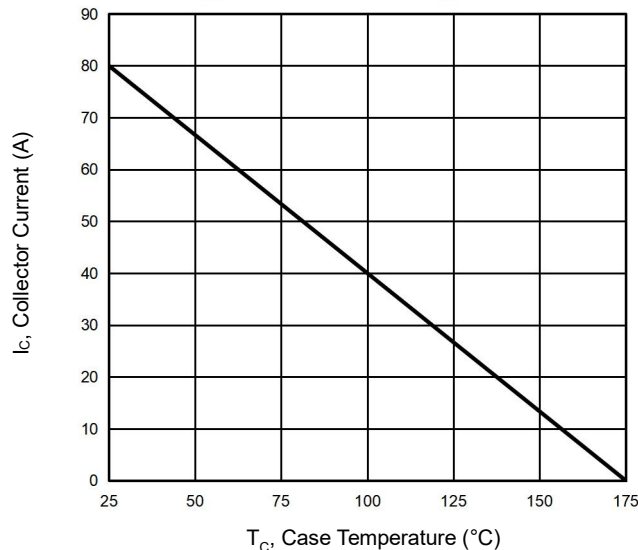


Figure 18 I_C vs. Temperature

Figure 19 Switching Time vs. I_C

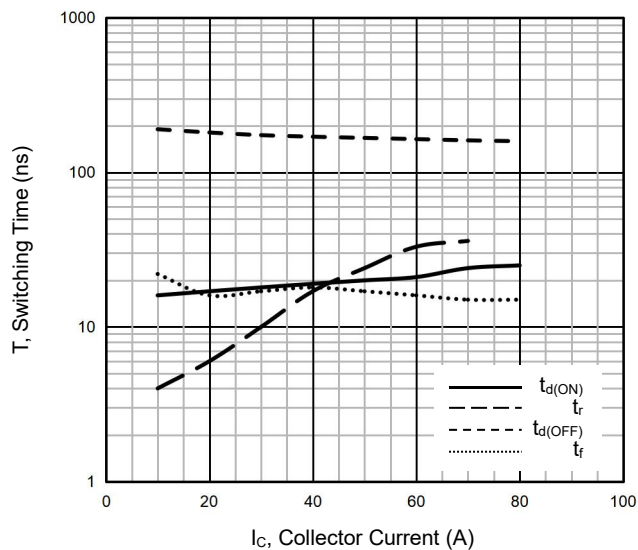


Figure 20 Switching Time vs. R_G

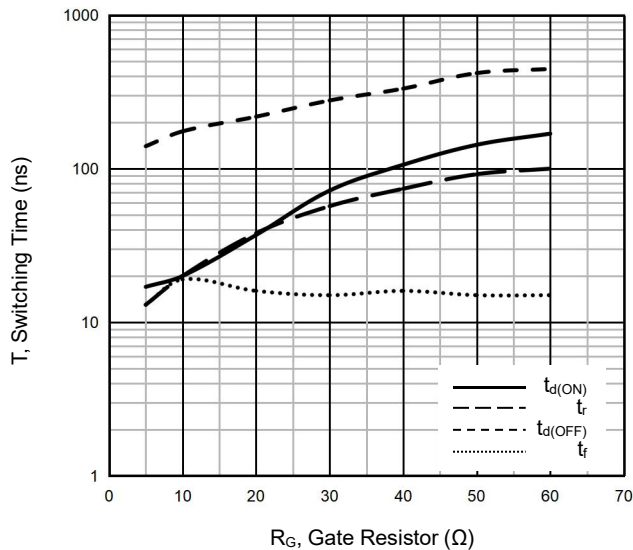


Figure 21 $V_{CE(sat)}$ vs. Collector Current

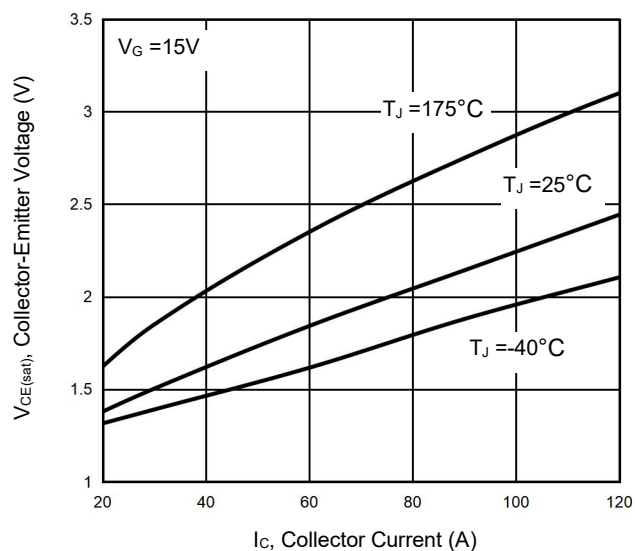


Figure 22 Switching Loss vs. V_{CE}

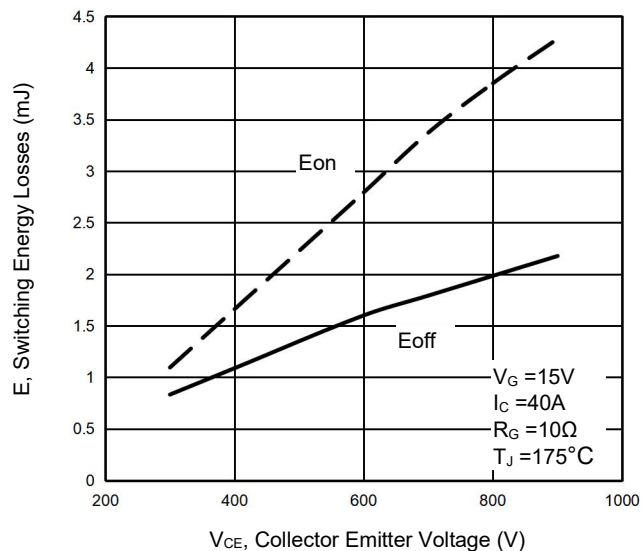


Figure 23 Switching Time vs. I_C

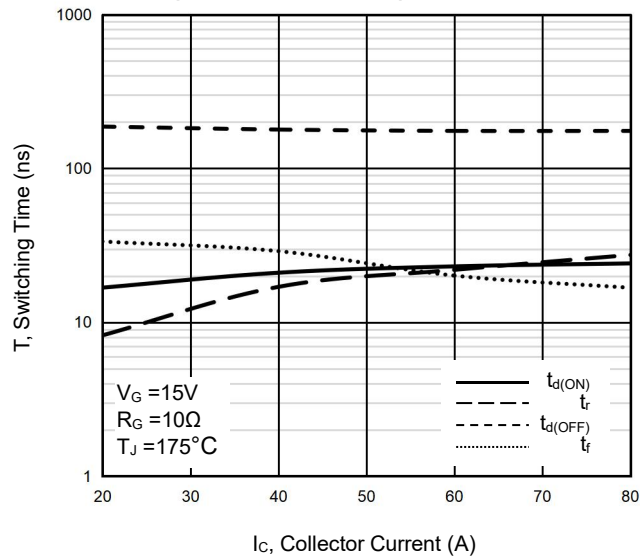
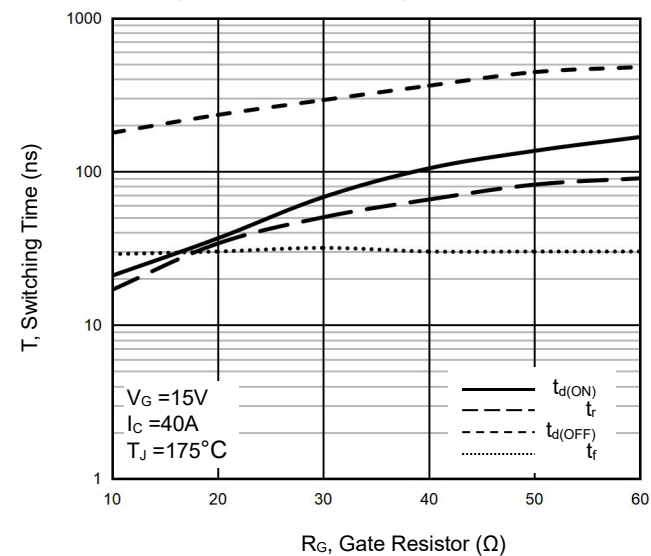
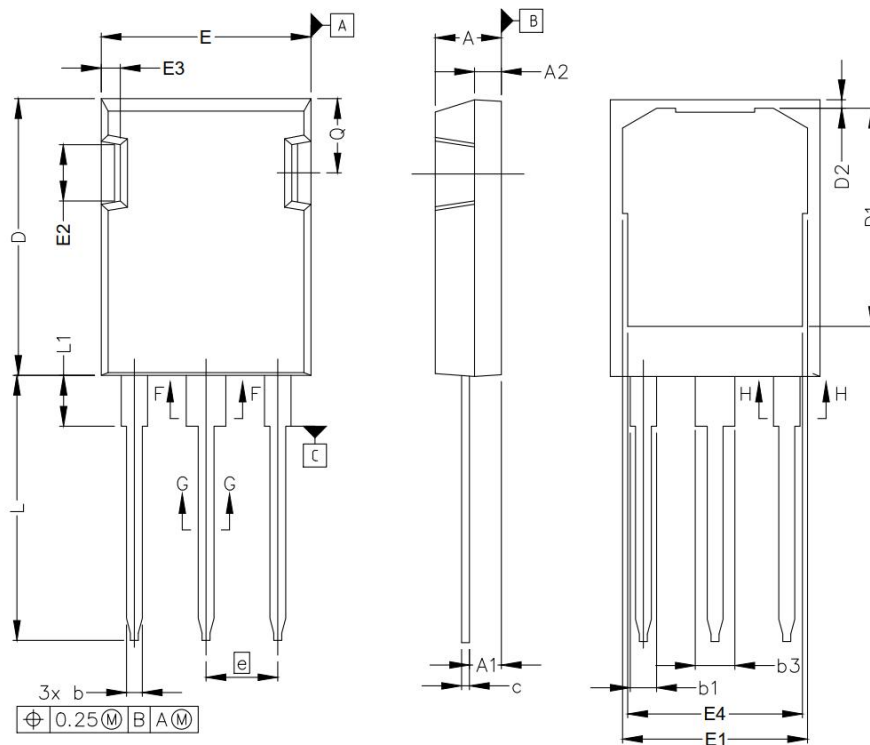


Figure 24 Switching Time vs. R_G

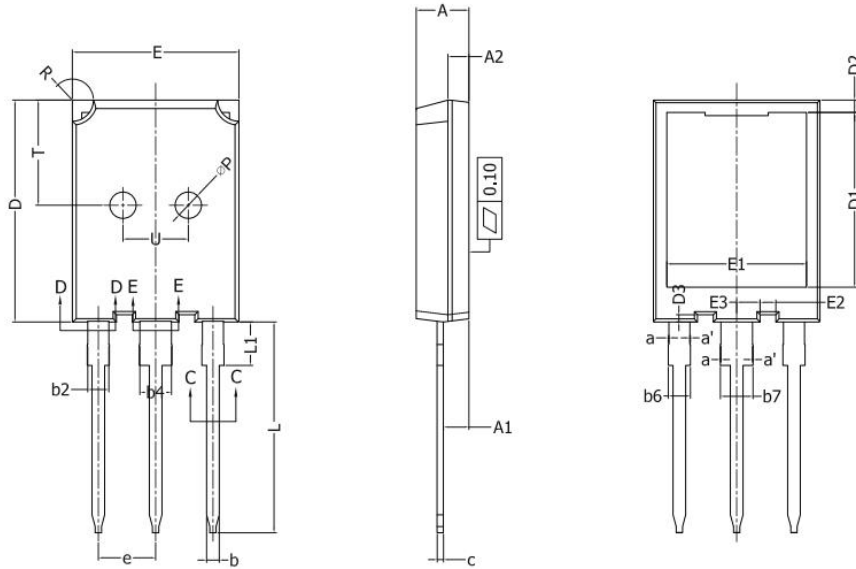

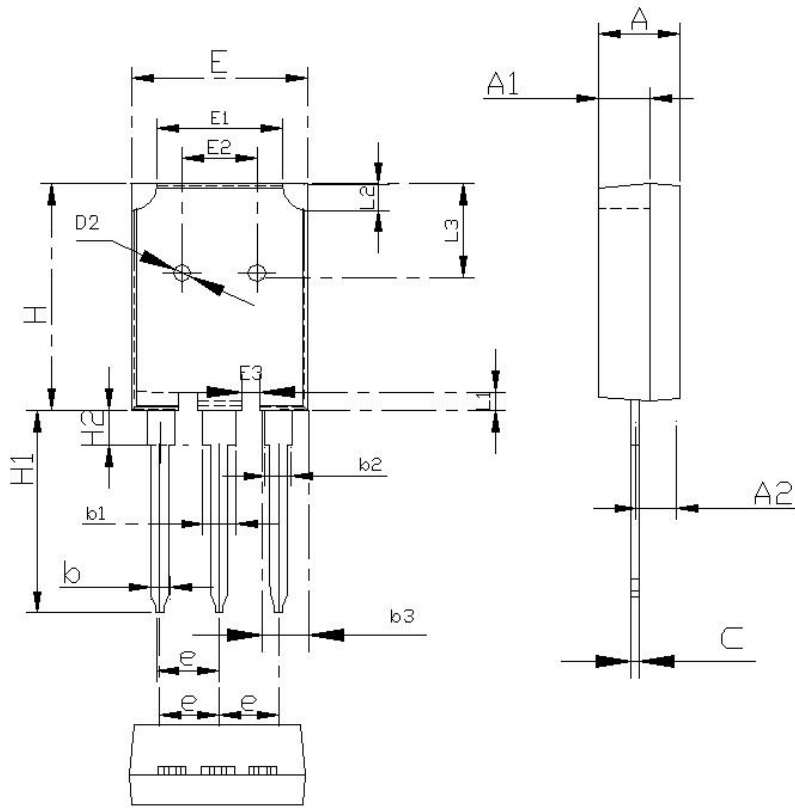

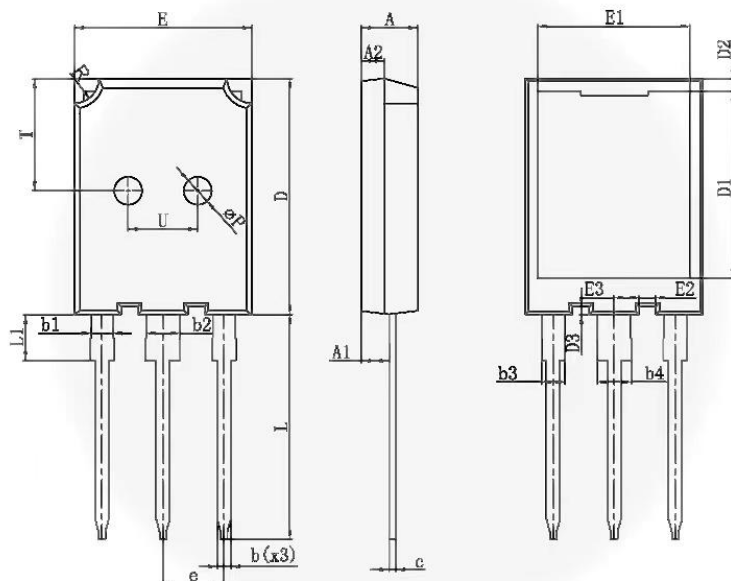
